It's summer and the livin' is easy. Or it should be. We don't want to spend our time cooking over a hot stove, so what do we do when we want a soup for lunch or dinner? We have a cold soup.

My favorite is Gazpacho. It is the ideal summer soup, not requiring cooking and can be prepared in a few minutes.

Ingredients

- 2 lbs ripe juicy tomatoes. *They must be fully ripe. The supermarket pale red just won't do. Some recipes call for tomato juice. Ugh!*
- 1 garlic clove
- 1/2 an onion, white, not sweet
- 1 green sweet pepper
- 1 cucumber, about 6-7 inches long
- 1/4 teaspoon ground cumin
- 3 tablespoons red wine vinegar
- 1/2 tablespoon salt
- 1/2 cup virgin olive oil
- 1 piece French bread (3-4 inches long)

Preparation

Take all the ingredients (*Those listed are just suggestions and can be adjusted or added to your taste. The bread can be included or reserved for croutons as I prefer*) and blend until smooth. It is best to make this ahead of time and chill until quite cold.

As we slowly get through the hottest and wettest part of the year on the Space Coast, here are some events and organizational needs to consider.

Part Two: Putting it Together

Theoretically, by the tenth of the month, all the contributions you will need will have arrived in the Editor's e-mail. I say "theoretically" because, like our speed limits in reality reflects the *minimum* speed one travels, the deadline date is apparently translated as "*Do not send before the tenth.*" That being said, let's look at our tools.

A good computer is a must. I use a laptop for all my computer needs, including putting together *The SCAM* each month. I strongly recommend that the computer you use is yours alone, and NOT shared with anyone else.

You will need reliable e-mail. I suggest a separate address for "all things Mensa". This is where you will receive all the submissions to the newsletter. It will also be the way you send to the printer and to our Webmaster for posting.

You will need a good desktop publishing program; I use MS Publisher 2010. If the incoming Editor chooses to use a different program, it would be wise to make sure the program can import a Publisher file.

Once the newsletter is created, I use **Adobe Acrobat X Standard** to create a .pdf file that can readily be sent to the printer and can readily be posted on the websites we use.

When I started editing *The SCAM* in late 2003, I received from our previous Editor the Publisher files of a few issues he had created. If you become the new Editor, I suggest you do the same thing. This will give you the current format of *The SCAM*, and when you open one of my files, you will effectively have a template to work from (it's a lot easier than starting from scratch). More importantly, opening one of my files will mean that you will have all the presets already, so your newsletter file will be "printer ready" without the necessity of navigating your publisher program to set it up correctly. When I started, I had absolutely NO experience in desktop publishing, so following what is now my suggestion was truly a lifesaver for me.

Be open to learning new things. In the nearly 12 years I have been Editor, in putting together *The SCAM* each month has never ceased to be a learning experience. You will no doubt have your own ideas on how *The SCAM* should be as a newsletter. Don't be afraid to pursue them; my only suggestion is to make the changes in increments, and allow the newsletter to gradually transform to the product you wish to create.

I have enjoyed my time here as Editor, but for personal reasons, it is time for me to move on. I have committed to remaining Editor for the rest of the current ExComm's term. If you are interested in becoming the next Editor, please let the ExComm know, and drop me an e-mail.

Last month's column necessarily came quickly after the Annual Gathering, and some corrections to the results of the Jewels Awards were made after I had submitted it. A spreadsheet error resulted in Tallahassee being given credit for the testing program points earned by Mensa of Jacksonville. When that was corrected, Mensa of Jacksonville earned the Class III Sapphire for 2015, while Tallahassee Mensa was awarded an Emerald. (Class III is for groups of between 200-399 members.) Also, due to a professional conflict, I will be unable to serve on the Finance Committee as I had announced last month in this column.

There is a meeting of the American Mensa Committee (AMC) scheduled for September 12 in Arlington, TX, but at this writing there is no agenda so I have no items to report on. (Such are the limitations of publication deadlines.) However, by the time you read this in your newsletter, the agenda will have been posted at <http://www.us.mensa.org/read/board-meeting-reports/> and can be selected from the dropdown box on that page. If you have anything you would like to comment on, please let me know.

I will be attending the Broward RG (FLoRanGe 2015: "Another Excuse To Each Chocolate!") on Labor Day weekend at the Courtyard Marriott. If you see this in time and haven't decided to go, I highly recommend it. I've been scheduled for an "RVC Rap" on Monday morning at 9:30, but will be available most of the weekend if you have anything you would like to discuss.
